

(Please note that although this is our usual timetable there may be changes due to other events/activities in school.)



- Ask them about their learning in school what have they learnt today? Can they show you some of the things they have done in maths? Could you research part of the topic together?
- Encourage them to complete their homework, making sure they write neatly and take care with presentation.
- Ensure they come to school every day at 8.50am.
- Practise counting in 1s, 2s, 5s, 10s and number bonds to 10.



<u>Maths</u>

The children will improve their mental maths skills through a variety of short burst activities using and applying their mathematical knowledge. We will be using the numicon shapes to develop our knowledge of numbers and what makes up a number. They will be developing counting, addition and subtractions skills. We will be finding one more and one less than a number and counting in 2s, 5s and 10s. We will begin to apply our skills to problem solving. We will developing our knowledge of 2D and 3D shapes.

English

Children will be revising and building on phonic and spelling knowledge from reception. We will continue to read and spell the tricky truck words.

They will be looking at a range of texts including traditional tales and different rhymes. The children will be exploring information books.

There will be a focus on handwriting throughout the year and we will be having weekly handwriting lessons as well as a weekly spelling test.

Please help support your children by changing library books regularly. Library books can be changed and every day after school between 3:30 and 3.45.

Computing

Our topic is 'We are treasure hunters'. We will be using the BeeBots to help us learn what is meant by the term algorithm. We will be learning how to control a programmable toy and record these instructions. We will be finding out about household items that are controlled by instructions.

Science

We are going to be discussing seasons and the changes that occur throughout the school year. We are also learning to name, sort and describe materials, exploring what they feel and look like and investigating their properties. During the second half term we will be finding out what castles are made of. We will be completing an investigation to discover which materials are waterproof.
