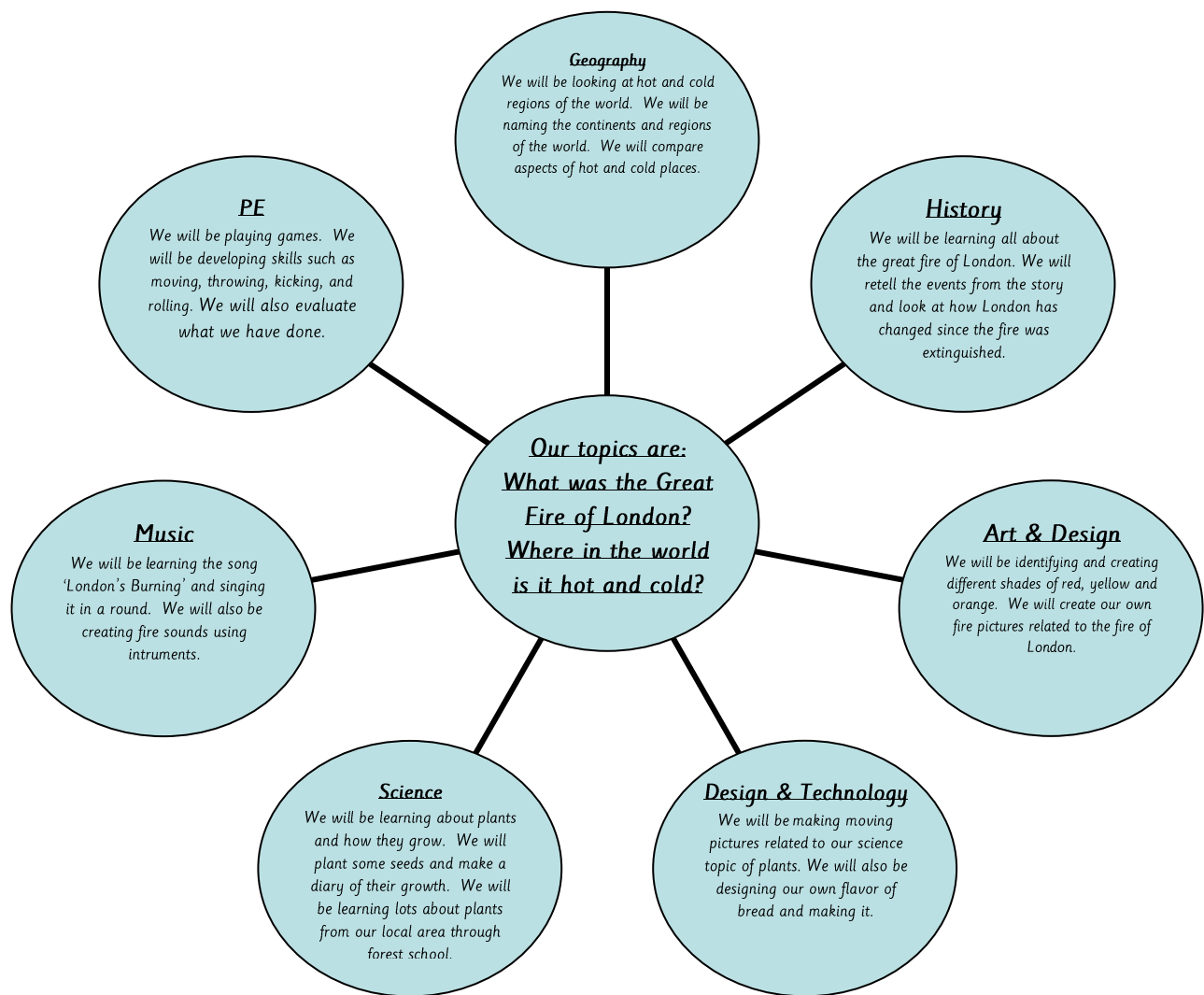

- Ask them about their learning in school – what have they learnt today? Can they show you some of the things they have done in any lessons? Could you research part of the topic together?

- Ensure they come to school every day at 8.50am.
- Ensure your child has a PE kit in school.
- Ensure your child has their reading books in school every day.



Maths

The children will improve their mental maths skills through a variety of short burst activities using and applying their mathematical knowledge. They will be applying their addition, subtraction, multiplication and division skills to problem solving tasks. We will continue to work on our 2s, 5s and 10s and counting to 100 forwards and backwards. We will begin to read and write numbers from 1 to 20 in words. We will practice recognising, finding and naming halves and quarters of quantities. We will also be learning about position, direction and turning.

English

Children will continue to develop their phonic knowledge through daily lessons. We will continue to read and spell the high frequency words in lessons and during spelling tests.

They will be looking at a range of fiction texts including 'Dick Whittington' and a variety of poetry and fantasy stories. We will be looking at the features of a non-fiction book and how to use it correctly through guided reading sessions.

We will be continuing to focus on handwriting through the summer term.

Please help support your children by changing library books regularly. Library books can be changed and every day after school between 3:30 and 3.45.

Computing

Our topic is 'We are travellers'. We will be using the program Purple Mash to create our own pictograph and bar graph. We will record data of our favourite colours.

Science

We are learning to name common and wild plants. We will also be continuing to observe changes through the seasons, focusing on spring and summer. We will also learn about deciduous and evergreen trees. We will plant some seeds and record the changes in a diary.
