Topic – set half termly and will have a given due in date.

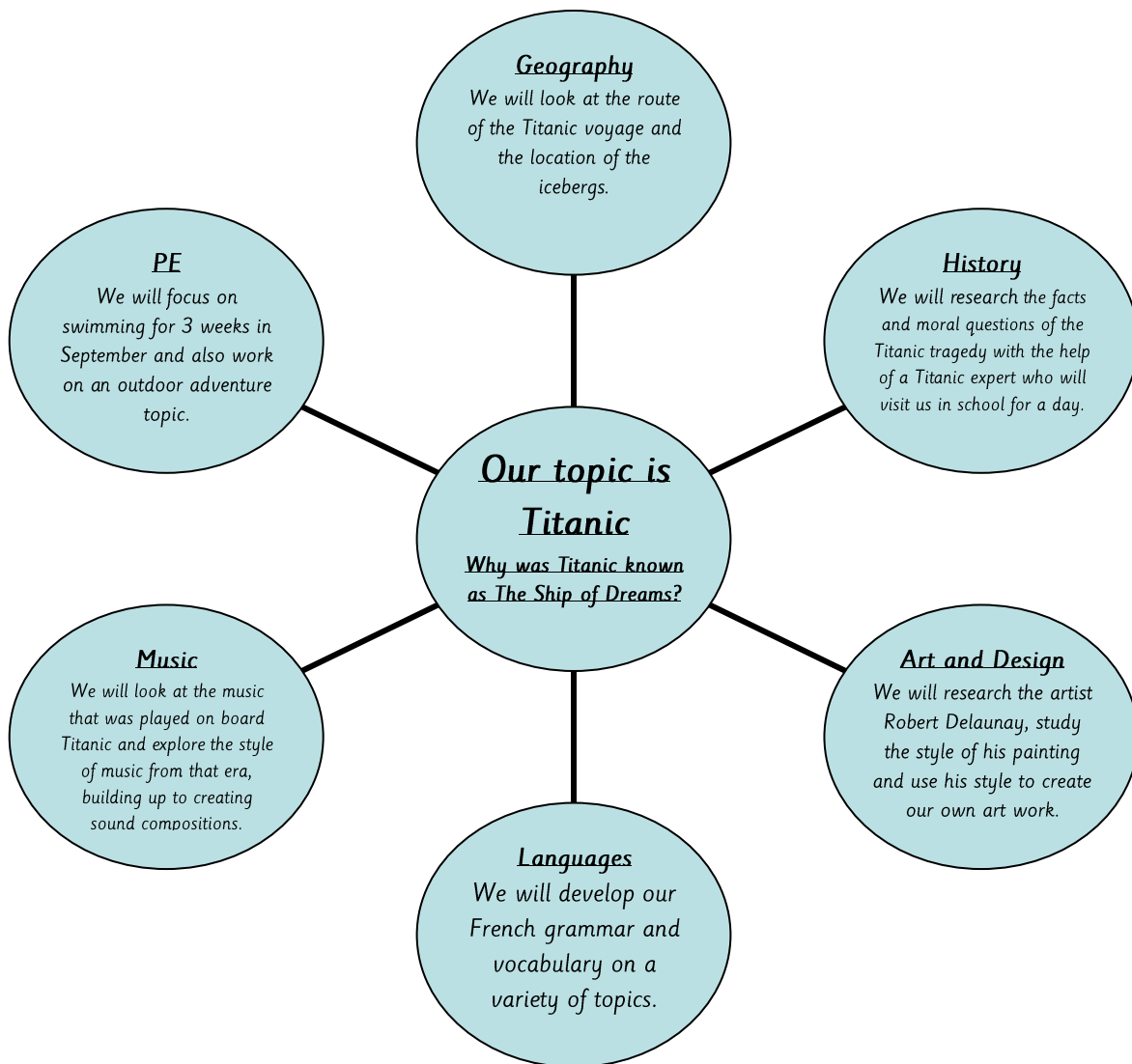
Spelling – set on Thursday and tested on Thursday.

Mathletics – we strongly encourage children to use this in addition to the paper homework set.

It would help your child if you could:

- Encourage children to read for a sustained period of 20 minutes each day.
- Ask them about their learning in school – what have they learnt today?
- Ensure children complete their homework independently, making sure they write neatly and take care with presentation, so that they can be proud of their achievements at home.
- Ensure they come to school every day at 8.50am.
- Ensure that the children have a bottle of water and a healthy snack for break time – no crisps or chocolate please.



Maths

We will begin the year with a focus on the place value of numbers and move on to using the written methods for all four operations without support of an adult. There will be a focus on the process of solving mathematical problems in a range of contexts. In geometry we will be looking at measures, shapes and angles.

English

We will be focusing on building up the children's use of adventurous vocabulary and develop their understanding and use of more complex sentences, which include a subordinating clause. There will be a particular focus on looking at their work and up-leveiling it with more advanced skills. There will be a big push on reading and answering questions about the text at speed and for prolonged periods. We are also looking forward to a poetry day in November.

Computing

This term, we will be exploring the topic of E safety. In each lesson, we will be sharing safety advice and teaching pupils how they can use the internet safely. We will discuss the important issue of privacy settings and making sure that private information is not shared in any way, including on social media and gaming websites. We will also talk about the children's support networks and who they can talk to if they feel unsure about anything online.

Science

During this term we will be focusing on light, prisms and the spectrum. We will discuss Newton's discovery of the spectrum and its use in Science today. We will be encouraging the children to develop their own questions and will be designing and conducting the relevant experiments to test their theories.
